Entry Requirements

Certificate

Any qualification equivalent to Certificate (Level 3, MQF)

SKM

A pass in SKM Level 3 in a related field, and a pass in SPM with a minimum of 1 Credit in any subject; and to take up a strengthening programme (if required)

Any other equivalent qualification as recognised by the Malaysian Government
